

Travelling in Grenoble

The easiest way to travel around Grenoble is to use the **Tram**.

Tram B – “Oxford” stop is the closest one to the EPN Campus (ESRF & ILL)

Tram B – “Marie Louise Paris CEA” stop is the closest one to the CEA

Tram B can also easily take you to the station **“Gares”** (in about 10 minutes) or to the city centre **“Victor Hugo”** (in about 15 minutes)



Going from the train station to the ESRF

3 Trams arrive at the train station (**“Gares”**), make sure to get onto **Tram B** towards **“Oxford”** (on the front display panel **Tram B** has a **green banner**).

Exit at the terminus **“Oxford” stop**, then walk ~400 m (in the same direction as the Tram was going) until a road junction: the ESRF & EPN campus site entrance will be on your left.

Make sure to validate your ticket before entering the Tram!


Buy a ticket from one of these machines

On the validator, present your contactless bank card or your connected object (phone or watch, with the NFC function activated).



The message "bank card validated" is displayed, **including in correspondence**.

Rates

€2.00 per trip!

valid for 1 hour from the 1st validation on [all M networks](#). Connections and returns authorized.

Capped at €6.40 per day!

When you make 4 or more journeys on the same day, the charge will be capped at the price of the 1-day ticket.
